Why should I get the HIV Test?



You may have the HIV virus and not even know it.

Just because you look healthy does not mean you are.

You should get tested if:

- You have abused drugs or alcohol.
- You have had an STD (a sexually transmitted disease).
- You have been sexually attacked.
- You have had sex without a condom, or your partner has had sex with others.
- You or your partner was given blood before 1985.
- You are thinking of having a baby.

You do not need the HIV test if:

- You have not had sex since 1978.
- You have had sex with only one person and you are sure that person has had sex only with you.
- You have never shared needles or had sex with anyone who shares needles.
- You were not given blood or blood products before 1985.

Remember:

- Taking the test is up to you. No one can make you take it.
- The test is private. Once you get your test results, <u>you</u> decide who should know.
