Starting October 1st, there will now be an organization working with Medicaid known as ACHN. This stands for "Alabama Coordinated Health Network." ACHN employees are there to help you make better choices in order to have better health outcomes for you and your baby. Social workers and nurses who work for the ACHNs provide this help to Alabama Medicaid recipients.

If you are pregnant, you can visit any doctor or OB/GYN who takes Medicaid starting October 1, 2019. You have the same Medicaid benefits from the Maternity Program both before and after this date.

Starting November 1st, ACHN staff will help you:

- Find a doctor or OB/GYN
- Find how to get services in the best place for you
- Make appointments, follow up with you to help you keep appointments, assist with referrals, and provide appointment reminders
- Solve problems so you can have a better quality of life
- Answer questions about maternity care and give advice about any problems
