Prenatal Care

(before the baby is born)

- First visit when you are pregnant
- Physical exams
- Ultrasounds
- Lab work
- ACHN Care Coordination services
- more

Postpartum Care

(after the baby is born)

- Coverage for 12 months postpartum
- Home and office visits
- In-hospital visits after delivery
- ACHN Care Coordination services

Delivery Care

- Vaginal delivery
- Cesarean section (C-section) delivery
- Anesthesia
- Hospitalization

Dental Care

- Dental services available for pregnant recipients through 60 days postpartum or until the pregnancy ends

Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP)

- Includes home visiting services for eligible pregnant women before and after the baby is born, and infant care until the child is two years old

Non-pregnancy health care may be covered for full Medicaid recipients.
