3 years and older

- SSI related protected groups deemed to be eligible for SSI/Medicaid
- Special HCBS Waiver disabled individuals whose income is not greater than 300% of the SSI Federal Benefit Rate
- Low Income Families with Children
- Federal or State Adoption Subsidy Individuals
