
PUBLIC NOTICE

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend its State Plan for Medical Assistance through a State Plan Amendment. This amendment will clarify the state covers and reimburses approved adult vaccines recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP). The estimated increase in expenditures for the state share for this State Plan Amendment is expected to be \$86,477.

A copy of the proposed changes will be made available upon request for public review at each county office of the Department of Human Resources and the State Office of the Alabama Medicaid Agency.
