DEFINITION OF SPECIALIZED SERVICES

Definitions

<u>Specialized Services for Mental Illness</u> - 24 Hour Inpatient Psychiatric Treatment including individualized comprehensive treatment planning by an interdisciplinary team under the direction/supervision of a QMHP and physician.

Specialized Services for Mental Retardation -

Continuous, aggressive, and consistent training to assist an individual to maintain or improve the current level of functioning in order for the individual to function with as much self-determination and independence as possible and to potentially prevent or decrease regression of functioning. Specialized Services for MR include individualized planning by an interdisciplinary team under the direction/supervision of a QMPR to assist an individual to achieve or maintain optimal functioning.

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CATEGORICAL DETERMINATIONS

Upon Level I identification of one of the following conditions:

- 1. Need for Convalescent Care of 120 days or less
- Terminal Illness with life expectancy of 6 months or less
- 3. Comatose
- 4. Ventilator Dependent
- 5. Functioning Only at Brain Stem Level
- 6. Cerebellar Degeneration
- 7. Advanced Amolytrophic Lateral Sclerosis
- 8. Huntington's Disease

and written certification by the attending physician of the above condition and that the NF applicant is not a danger to himself or others, the applicant may be admitted directly to a NF.

If the NF applicant has been identified as having any Suspected Mental Illness or Mental Retardation/Related Conditions, a determination of Specialized Services must be made although the individual may be admitted to a NF without a Level II evaluation before admission. Immediately upon admission to the NF, the NF must contact the OBRA Screening Office for a Specialized Services Determination to be made within seven working days from the date of admission to the NF.
